INDICATIONS: The PARI LC® D Disposable Nebulizer is used to deliver aerosolized medication to the lungs, with patients for whom a physician has prescribed medication for aerosol treatments in a home, doctor's office, hospital, or clinic environment.

I. GETTING STARTED


Before use, clean all parts (except tubing). See section II for cleaning instructions. To achieve the specified droplet characteristics, a liter flow of 3.5-8 liters per minute must be selected using wall air, wall oxygen or compressor (i.e. PARI Vios® or PARI Trek® S compressor systems).

- 1. Connect one end of tubing to air source.
- 2. Open top of nebulizer by twisting counter-clockwise, then lift up (Fig.1).
- 3. Pour prescribed medication into bottom of nebulizer. Maximum fill volume is 6ml.
- 4. Replace top of nebulizer. Semi-circle should face forward.
- 5. Attach mouthpiece or mask to nebulizer outlet (Fig.2).
- 6. Connect free end of tubing to bottom of nebulizer.



- 7. Turn on air source when ready to begin treatment.
- 8. Close lips around mouthpiece and inhale and exhale slowly. For mask, place the mask over nose and mouth and inhale and exhale slowly.
- 9. Repeat step 8 until medication is gone.

II. CLEANING THE PARI LC® D DISPOSABLE NEBULIZER





WARNING:

- 1. To reduce the risk of infection, illness, or injury from contamination, you must thoroughly clean all parts of the nebulizer as instructed after each treatment.
- 2. Never use a nebulizer with a clogged nozzle. A clogged nozzle can cause inadequate or no output or aerosol mist, resulting in improper treatment.
- 1. Remove tubing from nebulizer and disassemble nebulizer parts.
- 2. Wash all parts (except tubing) with warm water and liquid dish soap.
- 3. Rinse thoroughly with warm water and shake out water.
- 4. Air dry or hand dry nebulizer parts with a clean, lint-free cloth. Reassemble PARI LC® D when completely dry.

III. DISINFECTING THE PARI LC® D DISPOSABLE NEBULIZER



WARNING: To reduce the risk of infection and illness:

- 1. Nebulizer for single patient use (one person) only. Do not share your nebulizer with other patients.
- 2. You must regularly disinfect the nebulizer between treatments. Failure to do so could lead to serious or fatal illness.
- 1. Clean the nebulizer as described in section II. For low-level disinfection every other treatment day, soak all parts of the PARI LC® D nebulizer (except tubing) in a solution of 1 part distilled white vinegar and 3 parts hot tap water for 1 hour. You can substitute respiratory equipment disinfectants (like Control® III) for distilled white vinegar (follow manufacturer's instructions for mixing). Rinse all parts of the nebulizer thoroughly with warm tap water and dry with a lint-free cloth. Discard the vinegar solution when disinfection is complete.
